



CONSTRUCTIONLINE AND SSIP

Constructionline is a procurement and supply chain management scheme that collects, assesses and monitors standard company information based on PAS 91. They became a Founder Member of SSIP because they support the aims of reducing duplication and saving time and costs for both buyers and suppliers in prequalification.

Health and Safety is one of the mandatory sections of Constructionline. They will accept an SSIP member scheme certificate or an OHSAS 18001 certificate from a UKAS accredited certification body as an exemption from having to complete this section. Buyers can search the Constructionline database for suppliers using SSIP member certification as part of their search criteria. Many Constructionline buyers ask for SSIP member certification (or an appropriate OHSAS 18001 certificate) as a condition of working for them.

If suppliers do not have or wish to have an assessment from an SSIP member scheme then they will have to complete the health and safety questions. The answers can be viewed by buyers.

Note: Constructionline DO NOT assess the responses to health and safety questions.

A Constructionline certificate does not cover competence in health and safety management.

Other SSIP member schemes WILL NOT accept a Constructionline membership certificate as part of the Deem to Satisfy process.
